City of Danville announces appointment of ABC Administrator.

Danville City Manager, Paul Stansbury announces the move of the ABC direct responsibilities to the Police Department under Tom Bustle, Assistant Chief of Police.

“We have already started the transition, and Bridgette Milby, Director of Codes Enforcement/current ABC Administrator, will assist him and move into the role of Deputy ABC Administrator, which will allow her to focus on grant writing, research and administration along with other Codes Enforcement responsibilities,” said Stansbury. “I have every confidence that Tom will continue handling things in the same manner that Bridgette and the Codes Enforcement Department has and will do his very best to fulfill his responsibilities as ABC Administrator and Assistant Chief of Police.”

According to Milby and Stansbury, the move has been in the works since early 2010.

“Last January, Paul discussed with me his desire to have someone working in-house to research, write, and administer the City’s grants of which help support operations and our capital improvement projects,” Milby explained. “I was excited to have the opportunity of a new challenge in working with all of the city’s grants.”

Milby said the plan was delayed as a result of the Spring election, in which Danville voted to allow full alcohol sales within city limits.

“In March, we had the local option election that changed our alcohol status to ‘wet.’ It added a tremendous amount of work to my current ABC Administrator responsibilities and the Codes Enforcement Department. The additional workload put this transition on hold,” said Milby.

With the busy post-election licensing activities from the March vote now

settling down, Milby is excited circumstances are now allowing for a smooth transition.

“While we still have things to learn regarding the alcohol laws and licenses here in Danville, things are starting to settle into a manageable daily routine for alcohol administration and enforcement, which now allows for a change in my job responsibilities,” said Milby. I am excited to take on this new challenge and to work with Tom in his new role.”
