



# Memorandum of Agreement

## City of Danville,

Kentucky, United States of America

And

## The Borough of Carrickfergus

United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

Whereas, the above named entities recognize that a Memorandum of Agreement would be of mutual benefit and would serve as an indication of continued interest in co-operation and the pursuit of official Sister-City status as defined by the Sister-Cities international organization, it is understood that, from this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June in 2010, that:

1. Each entity will promote the exchange of citizens between their communities as a means of increasing tourism. Establishing business linkages and personal relationships;
2. Each entity will encourage joint projects and initiatives that enhance international relationships and build goodwill between the communities;
3. Participation in all travel, joint projects and initiatives will be detailed in supplements to this agreement and be voluntary on the part of all entities;
4. Any expenses incurred by entities under this agreement will be the sole responsibility of the entity, as enumerated in supplements to this agreements;
5. This Memorandum of Agreement will become effective on the final date of signing and will remain valid for four years or until the communities become official Sister-Cities as defined by the Sister-Cities international organization.
