**1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Commissioner Crowley made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Louis and unanimously approved upon roll call.

**2. ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW BOARD REAPPOINTMENT:**

Commissioner Caudill made a motion to approve the Mayors request and reappoint Lee Simpson to the Architectural Review Board as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Louis and unanimously approved upon roll call. This appointment is for a three-year period.

**3. PROCLAMATION – PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYORS WEEK:**

Commissioner Louis made a motion to approve the proclamation for the Professional Land Surveyors week as presented with noted spelling correction. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Crowley and unanimously approved upon roll call. Mayor Coomer read this proclamation in its entirety.

**4. HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REQUEST:**

Dwayne Campbell addressed the Commission and asked that the City look at donating two pieces of land to the Habitat for Humanity group for the building of houses. This will be brought back to the next meeting. No action taken at this time.

**6. 1<sup>ST</sup> READING – ORDINANCE #1728 ALCOHOL ORDINANCE:**

Commissioner Louis made a motion to approve the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Ordinance #1728 as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hamner and unanimously approved upon roll call.

**7. RESOLUTION #2008-03-10-01 – CODELL CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT:**

Mayor Coomer made a motion to approve Resolution #2008-03-10-01 deleting 9.1 of the agreement as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Crowley and unanimously approved upon roll call.

**8. 1<sup>ST</sup> READING – ORDINANCE #1729 ZONE CHANGE – MONTGOMERY:**

Commissioner Louis made a motion to approve the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Ordinance #1729 as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Caudill and unanimously approved upon roll call. This is the Montgomery zone change.

**9. PARKING COMMITTEE DISCUSSION:**

After discussion, the Commission asked that staff bring back parking committee recommendations at the next meeting for approval.

**10. NUISANCE ORDINANCE DISCUSSION:**

After discussion the Nuisance ordinance will be brought back to the Commission at the next meeting.

**11. PAYMENT OF THE BILLS:**

Commissioner Crowley made a motion to approve the bills from the General fund in the amount of \$72,848.08; the Utility fund in the amount of \$54,527.28, the Utility Capital fund in the amount of \$30,425.55 the Museum fund in the amount of \$646.93, the Parking fund in the amount of \$64,372.59 the stormwater fund in the amount of \$150.24, the Cemetery fund in the amount of \$245.24, and the garbage fund in the amount of \$54,527.28 for a total of \$223,248.14 as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Louis and unanimously approved upon roll call.

**12. FBI AUDIT:**

Communications Director, Robin Parks addressed the Commission and announced that the FBI had finished their audit of the 911 center and gave a wonderful report of full compliance. Congratulations IT and Communications.
