City Commission Meeting Highlights

Here's a summary of the key decisions and discussions from the June 2025 City Commission Meetings. City Commission Meetings are open to the public on the 2nd and 4th Monday each month at City Hall at 4:30 p.m.. They can also be viewed live or by recording at www.youtube.com/@CityofDanvilleKentucky

- **Pursuing Grants:** City Engineer, Josh Morgan, receives support from the City Commission to pursue a Land & Water Conservation Grant for improvements at Jackson Park, and a Recreational Trails Grant for extending trails, particularly along Lexington Avenue, continuing the connection of trails throughout the City.
- **Baughman Avenue Sidewalks:** The long-anticipated Baughman Avenue Sidewalk project moves forward as the City works with property owners to acquire right of way deeds.
- **Zoning Map Amendment:** City Commissioners heard comments regarding a zone amendment request for 901 Shakertown Road. The request was approved with conditions. Development of the property under the new R1-C designation will require prior site plan review and approval by the Danville-Boyle County Planning & Zoning Commission, KY Transportation Cabinet, Kentucky Division of Water and the City of Danville.
- **Housing Authority Board Appointment:** The City Commission appoints Ann Carter to serve on the Danville Housing Authority Board
- **Website Updates:** The City of Danville's website will undergo some maintenance and important updates. Changes can be expected in late July.
- **New Planning & Zoning Director:** Hannah Gray was selected by the Danville-Boyle County Planning & Zoning Commission to serve as Director. Hannah was introduced the Danville City Commission during the June 23rd Meeting
- **Preventing Check Fraud:** The City of Danville will take advantage of Farmers National Banks' Positive Pay service which aims to prevent check fraud for customers and City payments.
- **Budget Approval:** The Fiscal Year 2026 Budget was approved by the City Commission on June 23rd after a lengthy review. The budget will fund operations of the City of Danville from July 1, 2025 - June 30, 2026. The approved budget is available for viewing at www.danvilleky.org or by request at City Hall.
- **Welcome to Danville:** The City of Danville's welcome signs are nearly 25 years old and it's time for a refresh! We're excited to announce new welcome signs will be revealed later this Summer! Stay tuned for details.
