

City of Danville, KY Millennium Park Aquatics and Play Complex Estimated Cost \$15,000,000

Project Description:

For over 20 years, Danville and Boyle County have faced the dilemma of how to manage an aging and under-capacity aquatics facility that was originally constructed as a private facility and struggled to meet the needs of the general public. After years of public engagement and proposed plans, the City and County have reached agreement to move forward with the conceptual plan shown below at Millennium Park. This location for aquatics is actually the location shown in the original Millennium Park Master Plan from 1998, which is also shown below.

This proposed plan accomplishes several goals for the community including: modernization and expansion of aquatics options, addressing the growing demand for pickleball, relocation of Parks staff to the community's primary park, and modernization of a highly-used, 20-year old skatepark. The City and County have already committed a combined \$1,075,000 in the current budget for the construction of the pickleball courts and renovation of the skatepark. These first phase projects will meet short-term needs, but the construction of the pool, offices and parking will be the final pieces to completing central Kentucky's premier park.
