MONTHLY HIGHLIGHTS

JULY 2025

Here's a summary of the key decisions and discussions from the July 2025 City Commission Meetings, and other ongoing initiatives. City Commission Meetings are open to the public on the 2nd and 4th Monday each month at City Hall at 4:30 p.m.. - The City reappointed Ella Johnson to the **Human Rights Commission Board**
- An increase of the **Stormwater Management Fee**, which is applied to water bills, was approved by Ordinance #2053. The fee will now be \$3.75 after being previously set at \$3.36 in 2008. The Stormwater Fee funds stormwater projects around the City. Contact Engineering Department for more information.
- Improvements to the culvert on **Twinbrook Drive** are expected to begin in the fall of 2025, which will kick off a series of projects meant to address stormwater concerns in the area.
- The Danville 911 Dispatch Center has applied to receive a \$5,000 **Spark Good Grant** to assist with public education initiatives.
- The Cemetery Committee is reviewing comments regarding possible changes to **Cemetery Rules and Regulations** and plans to schedule a meeting with the City Commission to discuss current concerns before presenting a draft for review.
- The City Engineer will submit a **KYTC CPPP (County Priority Projects Program) Grant Application**, Requesting \$200,000 to pave Corporate Drive, with a \$50,000 Municipal Road Aid Match. The City believes the project will fit the criteria for this program and will open up funds for additional paving projects around the City.
- The City of Danville's Engineering Office is asking for public input on developing an **Active Mobility Plan** which informs decisions on sidewalks and trails around the City. Complete the survey at <https://www.danvilleky.org/467/Active-Mobility-Plan>
- The **City Engineer's Report** details upcoming traffic calming projects to be implemented on West Walnut, North Fifth, Seminole Trail and upcoming drainage projects on Brookhaven Dr, Lexington Avenue & 4th Street, Swope Dr, and Dillehay St - Watch the full 7/28/2025 meeting <https://www.youtube.com/@CityofDanvilleKentucky>
- **A request for proposal** has been published for potential tenants of the Jennie Rogers Early Learning Center. Letters of Intent were due on August 12th and full proposals are due on September 30th.
