

ORDINANCE NO. 2047

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONE FROM TWO FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (RM-2) TO HIGHWAY BUSINESS (HB) FOR APPROXIMATELY 0.155 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 714 HUSTONVILLE ROAD IN THE CITY OF DANVILLE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, at a public hearing held on February 26, 2025, Tyler and Hannah Isaacs, husband and wife, the property owners, by counsel, presented a petition for a zoning ordinance map amendment for 0.22 acres, more or less, of real property located in the City of Danville at 714 Hustonville Road from Two Family Residential (RM-2) to Highway Business (HB) and the Danville-Boyle County Planning and Zoning Commission, after making specific findings of fact, recommended approval of the zone change on February 26, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Danville agrees with the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Danville does now deem it appropriate to approve, ratify, and confirm the rezoning of the subject property by ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF DANVILLE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Zoning Ordinance for Boyle County and the Cities of Danville, Junction City and Perryville be amended to reflect a change in zone from Two Family Residential (RM-2) to Highway Business (HB) for 0.22 acres, more or less, of real property located in the City of Danville at 714 Hustonville Road, and depicted as Map No. D14-022-006 by the Boyle County Property Valuation Administrator.

Section 2: That the Danville-Boyle County Planning and Zoning Commission is directed to show the amendment of the official zone map atlas and make reference to the number of this Ordinance.

Section 3: The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any section, sentence, clause, or section of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any particular case is for any reason found to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect or repeal any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections or part of this Ordinance.


