- The City of Danville Fire Department Celebrates two retirements: Deputy Chief Mike Mulholland and Fire Marshal, Scott Lawson. Thank you, both, for your service to our community!
- The City of Danville has entered into an agreement to reserve the Traveling Vietnam War Veterans Memorial Wall for July 3-4, 2026 as part of the 250<sup>th</sup> Celebration for Boyle County and the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Military Appreciation festivities. - The City of Danville is accepting bids for roof repairs at the Public Works Garage.
- The City of Danville has approved the 2025 Paving List which includes the following streets or portions of these streets: Pontiac Ave, Waveland Ave, East Main, Old Second St, Davco Drive, Service Drive, Kemper Ln, Russell St, Twinbrook Dr, N Fifth St, Smoky Way, Montgomery Way and McClure Drive - Paving list is subject to change. - The City of Danville will initiate the foreclosure process on three vacant properties: 475 High St, 318 Caldwell St and 331 North Fifth Street


