### Highlights from October 2025 City Commission Meetings & Community Updates

The Danville City Commission meets on the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month at 4:30 p.m. in City Hall. Meetings are open to the public and can also be viewed live or recorded at [YouTube.com/@CityofDanvilleKentucky](https://www.youtube.com/@CityofDanvilleKentucky).

- The City of Danville celebrates multiple retirements: Fire Chief Doug Simpson, Fire Marshall Scott Lawson and Deputy Fire Chief Mike Mulholland and 911 Center Director, Rebecca Hafley. Congratulations, and thank you for your service!
- Following the passing of Commissioner Rick Serres, the Danville City Commission publicly declared the vacancy during the October 13<sup>th</sup> Meeting. As is the traditional practice for filling vacancies due to loss, the City Commission invited Audrey Serres to fulfill Commissioner Rick Serres' term. She has since accepted, and was sworn-in on October 27<sup>th</sup>, officially joining the City of Danville Board of Commissioners.

In the coming months, the skate community, park go-ers and community members will be asked to provide comments, concerns and suggestions to Danville-Boyle County Parks & Recreation ahead of this design.

### How it works:

Place your leaves in piles between the curb and sidewalk. If there is not enough room, place the leaf pile in the yard next to the sidewalk. **Do not** block the sidewalk. **Do not** place leaves in drainage ditches and **do not** place them on the street. **Do not** put limbs or other yard debris in the leaf piles and **DO NOT** put leaves in bags.

The provided schedule is weather-dependent. **Please have your leaves properly placed by your scheduled collection day but understand there may be delays due to weather or mechanical issues.** Catch-up days are scheduled to adjust for any issues that may arise.
