

ORDINANCE NO. 2000

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONE FROM RM-2 (TWO FAMILY RESIDENTIAL) TO RM-3 (MULTI FAMILY RESIDENTIAL) FOR APPROXIMATELY 10.691 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED ON THE END OF EAST MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF DANVILLE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, at a public hearing held on July 27, 2022, National Housing Associates, Inc., the applicant, along with Ryan A. Montgomery, Trustee of the Ryan A. Montgomery Living Trust, the property owner, presented a petition for a zoning ordinance map amendment for 10.691 acres, more or less, of real property located in the City of Danville on the end of East Main Street from RM-2 (Two Family Residential) to RM-3 (Multi-Family Residential), and the Danville-Boyle County Planning and Zoning Commission, after making specific findings of fact, recommended approval of the zone change on July 27, 2022, with the minutes being approved on August 24, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Danville agrees with the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Danville does now deem it appropriate to approve, ratify, and confirm the rezoning of the subject property by ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF DANVILLE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Zoning Ordinance for Boyle County and the Cities of Danville, Junction City and Perryville be amended to reflect a change in zone from RM-2 (Two Family Residential) to RM-3 (Multi-Family Residential) for 10.691 acres, more or less, of real property located in the City of Danville at the end of East Main Street, and depicted as Map No. 046-000-014 by the Boyle County Property Valuation Administrator.

Section 2: That the Danville-Boyle County Planning and Zoning Commission is directed to show the amendment of the official zone map atlas and make reference to the number of this Ordinance.

Section 3: The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any section, sentence, clause, or section of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any particular case is for any reason found to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect or repeal any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections or part of this Ordinance.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its final passage and publication, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in the Danville Advocate-Messenger of Danville, Kentucky.


