

ORDINANCE NO. 2003

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF DANVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 16 (TAXATION) ARTICLE II (OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES) TO CHANGE THE DEPARTMENT WHERE AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE IS APPLIED FOR AND OBTAINED.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Danville, Kentucky, find it necessary and appropriate to amend Section 16-17(a) to change the department of the City where an application for an occupational license is applied for and obtained;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF DANVILLE, KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

Section 16-17 (Occupational license application required) in Article 16 (Taxation) of the City of Danville Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-17. Occupational license application required.

(a) Every person and business entity engaged in any trade, occupation, profession or other activity for profit, or anyone required to file a return under this article in the city, unless exempt by the specific terms of this article, shall be required to apply for an obtain an occupational license from the city, through the ~~Office of Director of Codes and Financial Enforcement~~ Finance Department, on forms provided by the city or its designee, before the applicant shall be authorized to do business, before the commencement of business, or in the event of a change of business status. A one time occupational license registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be made at the time of application. A business changing its name shall notify the ~~Director of Codes and~~

~~Financial Enforcement~~ Finance Department of the name change, but shall not be required to pay a new occupational license registration fee.

(b) Each person shall be required to complete a separate application and pay the twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) registration fee for each separate business, before the commencement of business, or in the event of a status change other than a change of address.

(c) Licensees are required to notify the city of any changes in address, the cessation of business, or any other changes which render the information supplied to the city in the license application inaccurate.

(d) It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in any occupation, trade, profession or other activity for profit in the city without first having applied for and paid the occupational license registration fee herein required. If the occupational license registration fee is not paid prior to engaging in any business or activity, a penalty of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) may be imposed, in addition to any other penalties provided by this article for the period during which any unlawful business or activity occurred.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance is effective as soon thereafter as published in the Advocate-Messenger after two successful readings.

SECTION THREE: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is declared illegal or unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such declaration shall not affect the remaining portions hereof.


