

Boyle County Human Rights Commission

Meeting Minutes: 04/23/18

The scheduled meeting of the Boyle County Human Rights Commission was held at the Boyle County Courthouse, on April 23, 2018. Members in attendance: James Hunn, Susie Kelly, Anne Sleet, Arlen Finke, William Jenkins, and Kathy Miles. Also present: Judy Gooch, interpreter for the deaf, and one citizen. The meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM by Chairperson, James Hunn, with prayer by William Jenkins. It was determined that a quorum of the board was present.

The minutes of the March meeting were emailed by Kathy Miles. Motion to approve with one correction: that the woman who contacted James Hunn about housing and her children being removed was not from Boyle County, but was from Lincoln County, was made by William Jenkins and seconded by Anne Sleet. Motion carried.

Old Business:

There was no follow up report on a closed captioning ordinance, or on the Uniform Residential Landlord and Tenant Act.

As a follow up to previous issues related to the use of VRI in medical settings, Arlen Finke reported that a local interpreter for the deaf who attended a national conference learned there that VRI is not being used as much nationally and that live interpreters are the preference.

New Business:

Arlen Finke stated that he felt the M.L. King Walk was very good and informative.

Susie Kelly reminded everyone that Election Day is May 22, and that all should vote, and encourage others to vote, and remind people that absentee voting is available.

Due to the Memorial Day holiday, a motion was made by Susie Kelly, seconded by Anne Sleet to cancel the Commission's May meeting. Motion carried.

There were no complaints to be heard. There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Kathy Miles, seconded by Anne Sleet, and the meeting was adjourned at 6:15 P.M.
