Meeting Minutes: 10/22/18

The scheduled meeting of the Boyle County Human Rights Commission was held at the Boyle County Courthouse, on October 22, 2018. Members in attendance: James Hunn, Arlen Finke, Susie Kelly, William Jenkins, and Kathy Miles. Also present: Judy Gooch, interpreter for the deaf, and one citizen. The meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM by Chairperson, James Hunn, and prayer by Rev. Jenkins. A quorum of the board members was not present; therefore no action could be taken in the meeting.

James Hunn recommends that the Commission invite a representative of Lexington Fair Housing to Danville early in 2019, to share info on housing laws and support animals. This will be further discussed in the January meeting.

William Jenkins shared concerns about a physically challenged Danville resident whose landlord refuses to make the accommodations necessary for handicapped accessibility, in spite of assistance being offered by Helping Hands organization.
